Sub: - **Undue and unwarranted delay in extending the benefit of 78.2% IDA fixation to BSNL pensioners retired before 10.06.2013 - req.**

As you are aware the benefit of 78.2% IDA fixation was granted to the BSNL employees vide order dated 10.06.2013. Those who have retired after 10.06.2013 also are availing this benefit. However, in the case of the BSNL pensioners retired before 10.06.2013, the issue remains unsettled even after 27 months for one or other reason that may be best known to you.

The long and unexpected delay in settling the issue has created much resentment and anger on the affected BSNL pensioners. They have started asking the simple question as to why all these complex formalities on their case where as the employees and those retired after 10.06.2013 were granted the same benefit without any such hindrance.

Now, we understand that the Department of Expenditure has asked for certain clarifications and additional data in the Cabinet note. DoT in turn has asked BSNL to furnish the data and the BSNL Corporate Office in turn is seeking the required data from all the circles. This is a time consuming futile exercise as in the past. But Sir, we are at a loss to understand as to why the DoT should seek such data from BSNL, when all such details are very much available with DoT. Whenever a BSNL employee is retiring all the details are being sent to the respective DoT Cell of the particular circle and as such it could easily be collected from the DoT Cells, if not available with DoT, Delhi. Further, regarding the pre-2007 BSNL pensioners, their particulars were collected by the DoT a couple of years back for the pension revision of pre-2007 BSNL pensioners.

Therefore, we request your early kind intervention to avoid unnecessary delay in the matter. It is needless to point out that delayed justice is equal to denial of justice.
