Sub: - **Settlement of 78.2% IDA merger cases – delay in issuing PPOs and payment of arrear – req.**

Ref: - **Our letter addressed to you vide No.AIBDPA/DOT/2016 dated 23.11.2016**

We had brought to your kind notice that undue delay is being experienced in most of the circles in processing the cases of 78.2% IDA merger, mainly due to shortage of Staff vide our letter cited above, and the discussion had with you on 23.11.2016. Thus the target date, 31.12.2016 for complete settlement of the cases is jeopardised.

The feed back in this regard collected by us from certain circles is furnished below for your favour of information and necessary remedial action.

Maharashtra	35,000	Nil	Staff shortage.
Kerala	12,500	2,200	One Joint CCA, 2 deputy CCA posts are lying vacant. 2 JAOs retired. One typist deputed to AG's office TVM, substitute arrangements are to be made.
Rajasthan	7,877	700	Only 4 are deployed for this work. Burning of records recently has created the position worse and more staff to be posted.
Andhra Pradesh	13,600	1,900	Shortage of staff.
UP (West)	7,000	Nil	Shortage of staff.
Chhattisgarh	1,202	380	Though PPOs sent to Post Office no payment is being made for the settled cases.
Kolkata Telephones	7,000	Negligible	Only 2,500 received at CCA

Gujarat, Chennai Telephones and NE-I circles may complete before the target date, as reported by our representatives.

Your kind intervention is solicited for review of the cases circle wise and necessary action initiated for substitute arrangement of required staff by deputation / transfer and by giving honorarium for the existing staff, so that the process is completed within the minimum period. CCAs may please be directed to exhibit the exact position of 78.2% in their respective websites and updated regularly.

Sir, it may kindly be noted that the issue of 78.2% IDA merger was granted to the pensioners retired before 10.06.2013, only after a period of three years and further delay in implementation of the orders is causing much resentment among the affected pensioners. Therefore, I request you to kindly treat the issue with the importance and urgency it deserves.
