Sub: - Non-payment/ undue delay in payment of medical allowance (without voucher) due to insufficient allotment of fund-reg

Ref: - (1) This Association letter No.AIBDPA/BSNL-MRS/2018 dated 05-06-2018
(2) BSNL OM No.BSNL/Admin/15-22/14 dated 13th July, 2018.

We draw your kind attention to our letter referred (1) above, wherein we had pointed out the undue delay in payment of medical allowance without voucher. Now, BSNL has extended the benefit of medical allowance without voucher to the year 2018-19 vide OM referred (2) above.

But the fact remains that in certain circles like Telecom Factory, Mumbai, ETR etc, even the first installment of the year 2017-18 is yet to be paid and retirees naturally feel discriminated and disappointed. In most of the circles, the 3rd and 4th installments of 2017-18 are not paid. The Circle administrations, when contacted by our circle branches, state that unless and until they get the fund, they cannot pay.

Medical bills with voucher are also not being paid due to lack of fund, despite clear direction from BSNL CO to pay the bills of retirees within 30 days of submission.

Sir, this is causing much difficulties to the retirees, as they do not have any other source of income other than pension to meet their health issues. I would therefore request you to kindly cause necessary action to allot adequate fund to the circles for payment of medical allowance without voucher and medical bills with voucher.
